Geneva Woodall Spray of Chestertown, MD died Saturday, September 19, 2009 at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD. She was 92.

She was born on December 9, 1916 in Chestertown, MD the daughter of the late, Edward E. and Geneva Cochran Woodall. She graduated from Chestertown High School in 1936 and in 1943 married Robert C. Spray Sr.

Mrs. Spray spent most of her life as a homemaker raising and caring for her ten children. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Chestertown, MD. Mrs. Spray was well known for her homemade rolls and for babysitting and caring for not only her family but also her friend's children.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband, Robert C. Spray Sr. in 1991; two sons, J. Edward Spray, Thomas W. Spray; two daughters, Ann L. Wahlert, Betty E. 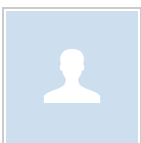
