July 10, 1915 - February 12, 2012

Genevieve Margaret Hutt of Ridgely, MD, died at her home on Sunday, February 12, 2012. She was 96.

Born July 10, 1915 in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late Andrew and Victoria Wanda Zajac Suski. She attended school in Baltimore and started working at the age of 14 at the Happy Hills Convalescent Home for Children in Baltimore, MD. On March 1, 1937, she married Montague John Hutt of Baltimore.

Later in her life she worked for Schaub's Department Store in Baltimore. Mr. Hutt died March 19, 1980. In 2002, Mrs. Hutt moved to the Eastern Shore and made her home with her daughter.

Mrs. Hutt is survived by two daughters, Betty Jean Ruhe and her husband, Frederick of Ridgely, MD, and Patricia May Teal and her husband, Edward of Berlin, MD; two sons, Montague John Hutt, Jr. and his wife, Deloris of Pasadena, MD, and William Victor Hutt, Sr., and his wife, Susan of Pikesville, MD; 10 grandchildren; 18 great-grandchildren; and four great-great-grandchildren.
