



Geoffrey Bentham Sherwood

November 20, 1943 - September 15, 2023

Geoffrey Bentham Sherwood of Queenstown, MD passed away peacefully, surrounded by family, on September 15, 2023, at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 79.

Born on November 20, 1943, in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Thomas and Dorothy Sherwood. Geoffrey married A. Dawn Bogosian on October 29, 1967, and they moved to Maryland over 50 years ago. In 1980, Geoff founded Sherwood, Logan & Associates, a successful water and wastewater treatment equipment company. His hobbies included fishing, golfing, traveling, and spending time with his grandchildren.

Geoff is survived by his daughter, Heather Mahaffey and her husband Christopher; three grandchildren: Grant, Ella and Patrick; and his brother, Robert Sherwood. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife of 52 years, Dawn, and their son, Gregory Sherwood.
