George Wallace Crown of Chestertown, Maryland died on July 22, 2001 at Kent and Queen's Hospital in Chestertown. He was 76.

He was born in Derwood, Maryland on August 7, 1924, the son of the late Frank Montgomery and Agnes Bean Crown.

Mr. Crown served his country during WWII with the U.S. Army in the both the European and Asiatic/Pacific Theatres. He was honorably discharged in January of 1946. Mr. Crown worked for PEPCO Power Company for 34 years, retiring in September of 1979. He was married to N. Ellen Tierney on June 15, 1967; they resided in Silver Spring, Md. and spent summers in Rock Hall, Md. They moved to Rock Hall upon Mr. Crown's retirement and then moved to Chestertown, Md. in 1990.

Mr. Crown was a member of Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 Chestertown, Md. and Chester River Yacht and Country Club where he was very active in M.I.S.G.A. Golf outings.

He enjoyed golfing, boating, and crabbing on the Chester River.

In addition to his wife of 34 years he is survived by 2 sons: George T. Crown of Glenwood, Md. and John W. Crown of Olney, Md.; 2 daughters: Grace Ellen Crown of San Antonio, Texas and Pamela Nebel of Damascus, Md.; 3
