



George Davis Faulkner

September 8, 1929 - July 19, 2013

George Davis “Dave” Faulkner, died peacefully at his home on July 19, 2013, in Seaford, DE, surrounded by his loving family. He was 83 years old.

Dave was born September 8, 1929, in Easton, MD, the son of George Dewey and Evelyn Davis Faulkner. He was a graduate of St. Michaels High School. He served in the Korean War and returned home to work as a waterman on the Chesapeake Bay, owning the Skipjack, Martha Lewis. He owned and operated several canneries on the Eastern Shore, running as the Williamsburg Canning Company, and served for two terms as President of the Mid-Atlantic Food Processors Association.

He loved to travel, visiting 60 countries in his lifetime. He was an avid boater as well, traveling up and down the East Coast.

He is survived by his three children, Steve R. Faulkner and his wife Linda of Federalsburg, MD, John Timothy Faulkner and his fiancée, Carol Pickett of Jensen Beach, FL, and Jodie Faulkner Henry and her husband, Eric of Laurel, DE; his best friend, Ken Lednum of Hurlock, MD; former wife, Jessie Mae Faulkner of East New Market, MD; six grandchildren, five great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

A celebration of his life on earth will be held on July 24, 2013, at 1 p.m. at

Tilghman Methodist Church, where the family will receive friends from 12 to 1 p.m. Interment will follow at St. John's Cemetery , Tilghman, MD.
