December 20, 1931 - March 10, 2012

George H. Gronde of Queenstown, died Saturday March 10, 2012 at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD. He was 80.

Born on December 20, 1931 in Red Bank, NJ, he was the son of the late, Franklin Joseph and Katharine Holmes Gronde. George was a graduate of Asbury Park High School and the University of Delaware with a degree in chemical engineering. His 40 year career in chemical engineering was spent with Hercules, Inc. and he resided in Wilmington, DE, Hattiesburg, MS, Burlington, NJ, Louisiana, MO, Spartanburg, SC, Wilmington, NC and ended his career back in Wilmington, DE as a process technology manager. In 1996 after retirement they moved to Queenstown, MD where he enjoyed boating on the Chesapeake and traveling. George also completed and received his education for ministry from St. Luke's Seminary. He is an Eagle Scout, an active member of Christ Episcopal Church in Stevensville, MD, member of the Sudan Shriners of Newbern, NC, and went thru the Masonic order in Louisiana, MO.
