July 22, 1929 - January 25, 2018

George H. Higgins died on Thursday, January 25, 2018, at Candle Light Cove Assisted Living in Easton, MD. He was 88.

Born on July 22, 1929 in Easton, he was the son of the late Daniel H. Higgins and Florence Fairbank Higgins.

He attended St. Michaels High School, graduating with the Class of 1946. George served honorably in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict.

On August 14, 1953, George married Margaret J. Jones, and they made their home in Neavitt, MD.

George worked on the water, oystering and crabbing. In the 1960's, he captained the Oxford-Bellevue Ferry and the cruise boat "Patriot" for the Maritime Museum in St. Michaels. Mr. Higgins' brother began Higgins Restaurant, where George worked as a bartender and assisted in their catering business. He is a past member of the Miles River Yacht Club, the Moose Lodge of Easton, and the VFW.

George is survived by his wife of 64 years, Margaret Higgins; his son, G. Herman Higgins, Jr., and his wife, Suzi, of Easton; two grandchildren, Sean Higgins and Sarah Mickey and her husband, Keith; great-grandson, Xander Mickey; siblings, David Higgins and his wife Terri of Preston and Edith Mae
