George "Bill" Linzey of Oakland, Maryland died Wednesday, February 16, 2005 at his residence. He was 81.

Born April 2, 1923 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Harry and Margaret Droll Linzey. He served his country in the United States Air Force during World War II and following his release from active duty he went to work for J.L. Sherman & Company Heating and Air Conditioning, where he served as foreman.

He was a member of the American Legion in Oakland, a member of St. Dennis Catholic Church in Galena, MD and attended St. Peters Catholic Church in Oakland. He loved hunting, especially big game hunting, flying and maintained his flying license until 2004. He enjoyed reading, especially hunting journals and history. Mr. Linzey is survived by his wife of 58 years, Doris Mary Linzey of Oakland, MD; a grandson, John Andrew Krastel, Jr of Kennedyville, MD and a granddaughter, Cheri K. Hill of Briston, VA.
