George W. Macey, was fatally injured in a motorcycle accident while on his way to work, Wednesday, January 9, 2019. He was 58.

Raised in Caroline County, MD, and a graduate of Colonel Richardson High School, he was the son of George and Gertrude Macey of Harmony. George was a proud civil servant of the Department of Defense; dedicated, hardworking and proud to serve his country.

Along with his love of all things motorcycle; disassembling and repairing them, Tail of the Dragon Trips and award-winning antique motorcycles, he enjoyed camping and his annual Christmas displays.

George is survived by his wife of 39 1/2 years, Anita Watkins Macey; his children, Cindy Jones (Travis) of Mardela Springs, MD, Lisa Baker of Easton, MD, and David Macey of Virginia Beach, VA. He is also survived by his grandchildren, Hailey and Sarah Jones, Isaac Macey and his sister, Vista Cheesman of Preston.

George was a loving husband, a proud father and devoted grandfather. He will be deeply missed by his family and many friends and staff at Ft. Meade.
