



## George Wayne Marquess Sr.

February 18, 1944 - February 16, 2017

George Wayne Marquess, Sr., of Harrington, DE, passed away on February 16, 2017, at his home. He was 72.

Born on February 18, 1944, in Baltimore, MD, the son of the late George Washington and Joan Margaret Appel Marquess, he was raised in Gambrills, MD, and graduated from Arundel High School, Class of 1963. George went to work for Reliable Contracting Company in Millersville, MD. In 1965, he was drafted into the U.S. Army where he served two years stationed in Germany as part of a hawk missile battalion. George returned to work for Reliable Contracting, and, in 1985, he went to work for David Bramble, Inc., as a gravel pit foreman until he retired in 2011.

He married Marjorie Ann Dorr of Crownsville, MD, on February 7, 1970. George was an avid outdoorsman. He enjoyed fishing and hunting deer and turkey, and was a member of the National Rifle Association.

George is survived by his wife, Marjorie Ann Marquess; son, G. Wayne Marquess, Jr. and his wife Melinda of Felton, DE; daughter, Dana Leigh Marquess of Harrington, DE; brother, James Russell Marquess of Chesapeake Beach, MD; grandchildren, Reuben Russell Marquess of Felton, DE, and Leanna Grace Marquess of Felton, DE. He was predeceased by a son, Russell Paul Marquess in 1987.

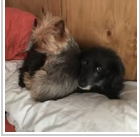
