George Miller, Jr. of Chester, MD died at Anne Arundel Medical Center on Thursday, August 14, 2003. He was 72.

Born on July 3, 1931 in Boston, MA, he was the son of the late George Miller, Sr. and Martha Karlson. He was a graduate of Somerville High School, Class of 1948. Following graduation he served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War from 1948 to 1954 in Germany and Austria. Several years later he would work for the U.S. Department of Foreign Service, serving in Cambodia, India and Thailand. Mr. Miller would then begin his career with IBM as a Systems Engineer within the greater Washington area. He retired after 30 years in 1992. Upon retiring, he moved to the Kent Island area. Mr. Miller enjoyed collecting lighthouses and paintings by Paul McGehee denoting his love and admiration for the beauty of the bay area. He was active with the Chesapeake Bay conservation and member of the American Legion post #297, U.S. Power Squadron-Kent Narrows and was an avid Republican.

Mr. Miller is survived by one son, George Miller, III and his daughter in law, Kimberly Miller of New Market, MD; one daughter, Helen M. Miller of Virginia; one sister, Clare A. Miller of Massachusetts and two grandchildren, Mackenzie Miller and Nicholas Miller.
