George Thompson Myrick of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, August 29, 2012, at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 85.

Born on February 10, 1927, in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late, George and Edith Myrick. He grew up in Baltimore, MD, and graduated from Friends School in 1945. Immediately after graduation, he entered the United State Navy and served until 1946. Mr. Myrick attended Swarthmore College and graduated in 1950. He and his wife, Barbara lived in Rodgers Forge for thirty years where he worked for the Friez Instrument Division of Bendix Corporation from 1951 to 1967. He then worked as a personnel director of Good Samaritan Hospital from 1967 until his retirement in 1983.

Mr. Myrick coached the Kelly Post Lacrosse Team in the Maryland Midget Lacrosse League, where his teams included numerous future college players. He moved to Chestertown, MD, in 1985, where he enjoyed caring for his piece of earth in the land of pleasant living, visiting with his grandchildren, and following Hopkins Lacrosse.

In addition to his wife of 60 years, Barbara, he is survived by two children, Kathy Myrick of Durango, CO, and Tom Myrick and wife, Patty of Charlotte, NC; five granddaughters, Amy Davlin, Rebecca DeProspero, Olivia Myrick, Rachel Myrick, and Natalie Myrick, and one great-grandson, Sam Davlin.
