September 16, 1918 - November 1, 2008

George Olszewsky of Chestertown, MD died Saturday, November 1, 2008 at his home. He was 90.

Born September 16, 1918 in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late, Frank and Josephine Bonowitz Olszewsky. Mr. Olszewsky attended Penn State University, where he studied Engineering. As a young man he served in the Civil Conservation Core. Mr. Olszewsky served his country in the 1st US Marine Corp. during WWII in Iceland and in the South Pacific. After an honorable discharge he went to work as a Tool Design Engineer for Piasecki Helicopter Co. which eventually became Boeing ASA Company. He retired in 1980.

Mr. Olszewsky was a member of St. Johns Catholic Church and Rock Hall Senior Center. He enjoyed carving and gardening.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters, Wanda McKinny, Regina Lynch and two brothers, Stanley and Bernard Olchewsky.

Mr. Olszewsky is survived by his wife, Emma Margaret Olszewsky of Chestertown, MD; two sons, George R. Olszewsky of Holmes, PA and Michael F. Olszewsky of Centreville, MD; one daughter, Pat J. Normile of Glenside, PA; one sister, Josephine Fanning of Philadelphia, PA; one brother,

Joseph Olchewsky of Media, PA and eight grandchildren.

Services will be held at St. Johns on November 14, 2008 at 11AM. A graveside service will be held privately in Arlington Veterans Cemetery.
