George Edward Stubbs, Jr., of Chestertown, MD, passed away on Saturday, April 28, 2018, at his home with his loving wife, Lydia, by his side. He was 90.

Born on January 14, 1928 in Massey, MD, he was the son of the late George Edward, Sr. and Lulu Elizabeth Tate Stubbs. He enlisted in the United States Army in 1950 and was honorably discharged in 1952. Mr. Stubbs worked as a Custodian for Kent County Board of Education and Queen Anne's County Board of Education. He also worked as a heavy equipment operator with Sabatino Bros. Construction and was a Bridge Tender at the Sassafras River Bridge for 13 years. On October 25, 2003, he married Lydia Wallace.

Mr. Stubbs was a member of the Rock Hall American Legion, Sgt. Preston Ashley Post #228. He loved to garden, watch wrestling, and spend time with his family and friends.

In addition to his wife, Lydia Stubbs, he is survived by three sons, Ronald Stubbs and Joan of Fountain, CO, Thomas Stubbs of National Park, NJ, and Alfred Stubbs and Penny of Pilesgrove, NJ; one daughter, Deborah Stubbs; one brother, John Stubbs of Easton, MD; seven grandchildren; one great-grandson; and many nieces and nephews that he loved. He is also survived by Gabe, a special great nephew, whom he really enjoyed spending time with.

He was predeceased by his four sisters, Louise Walters, Virginia Lord, Patricia Holt, and Dorothy Simpler, and one brother, William Stubbs.
