On Sept. 2, 2001, George D. Young, Sr. of Centreville MD died at the Meridian Center, Corsica Hills in Centreville Md. He was 95 years old. Born on Sept. 23, 1905 in Bridgeville Del. the son of Charles and Maggie Lewis Young. He attended school in Bridgeville DEL. On July 1, 1935 he married Mary Emily Morris of Greenwood DEL

Mr. Young began working for John J. Raskob Estate at Pioneer Point, Centreville MD as a painter and later became the painting foreman. In 1951 he started in business for himself as George D. Young Painting of Centreville MD. He specialized in wallpaper hanging and painting for large estates in Queen Anne's County. His son later joined him in painting business. Mr. Young worked well into his eighties.

Mr. Young is survived by his wife: Mary Morris Young, two sons: George D., Jr. and William M. Young both of Centreville MD. Four grandchildren: Kimberly Pillas of Lutherville Md., Gina Lowther of Catonsville MD, Wendy Dyott of Easton MD, Stacy Woodworth of Ridgely, MD. He was past member of the Queen Anne's County Sportsman Club, and a member of The Centreville United Methodist Church in Centreville MD. When his children were younger he was very active in the Centreville Little League Baseball program.
