George Earl Jarboe of Stevensville, MD, beloved father, brother and grandfather, died suddenly on Saturday, January 26, 2002 at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD. He was 51.

Born on July 21, 1950 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Joseph B. and Elizabeth Seidlich Jarboe. He attended school at Saint Marks and later Mount Saint Joe's in Catonsville, MD. He enlisted in the Air Force and served during the Vietnam War as a crew chief on an F-4 out of Thailand. Returning home to Catonsville he served his apprenticeship and became a carpenter with Union 101 Carpenter District Council of Baltimore. He would later move to Stevensville, MD in 1981. Mr. Jarboe was currently working with Giant Foods as a carpenter. He was a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church in Chester, MD and was as avid outdoorsman as he loved recreation that the Eastern Shore offered. And was very gracious & helpful to any one in need always thinking of others before himself.

He is survived by two daughters, Natalie Jarboe of North Carolina, and Rebecca J., Jarboe of Stevensville, MD; a son, Michael F. Jarboe of Cheyenne, WY; three brothers, Stephen Jarboe of Catonsville, MD, Bud Jarboe of Dover, DE and James Jarboe of Lansdowne, MD and a granddaughter, Emily Jarboe. A brother Joseph Jarboe predeceased him.
