George Edward "Eddie" Fluharty, Sr., of Tilghman died at his home on Saturday, November 5, 2005. He was 80.

Born on Tilghman Island, September 21, 1925, he was the son of the late Wilmer W. Fluharty Sr. and Dorinthia Agnes Fluharty. A lifelong resident of Tilghman Island, Mr. Fluharty graduated from St. Michael's High School in 1942. He then served in the United States Army from 1943 to 1945. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Tilghman where he entered the family business Fluharty's Boatyard on Knapps Narrows. A business that he maintained with his brother "Buck" until 1975. He then established, St. Michaels Realty with his partner the late Robert Vojvoda, where he remained until his retirement.

Mr. Fluharty was a member of Granite Lodge #177 A. F. & A. M., St. Michaels where he was past master. His memberships also include B. P. O. of the Elks #1622, E. E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 V.F.W., Easton, a member of the St. Michaels Rotary, Miles River Yacht Club, Harbourtowne Golf Association, M. I. S. G. A. Senior Group at Harbourtowne and Easton Club. He was also one of the founding members of the Tilghman Little League where he served as coach and manager. Mr. Fluharty loved restoring boats, golfing, yachting, fishing and motorcycling. He was a very active outdoorsman.

He is survived by his wife, Lois "Pete" Fluharty, three children; Wendy Lou Castellana of Atlanta, GA, Cathy Jo Stinchcomb of Claiborne, MD, George "Ed" Fluharty Jr. of Easton, two step children; Lynne Bergeron of McDaniel and Kelley Cox of Tilghman, one brother; W. W. "Buck" Fluharty, Jr. of St. Michaels and a special nephew, Douglas Fluharty; six grandchildren; two step grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. He was predeceased by one granddaughter, Tasha Lynn Stinchcomb.

A memorial service will be held at the Tilghman United Methodist Church on Saturday, November 12, 2005 at 11:00 a.m.

Burial will be private.
