A Funeral Liturgy will be celebrated for George F. Dulin, Jr. at St. Michaels Mission Chapel, St. Michaels, MD on Wednesday, December 7, 2005 at 10:00 AM. Mr. Dulin died on Thursday, December 1, 2005 at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines, Easton, after an extended battle with Alzheimers. He was 62.
