A funeral liturgy for George G. Carr of St. Michaels, MD, formerly of Hazlet, N.J. and Lord's Valley, PA will be celebrated at the St. Michaels Catholic Chapel, St. Michaels, MD on Monday, November 26, 2001 at 10:00 AM. He died on Thursday, November 22, 2001 in Galloway, NJ. He was 77.

Born on February 25, 1924 in Donegal, Ireland he was the son of the late George G. and Bridget McDevitt Carr. He graduated from Christian Brothers High School in New York and then during WWII joined the United States Air Force as a Corporal in the 58th Fighter Squadron, serving in Berma and China. Following his release from active duty he began a lifelong career in the men's clothing business. Prior to his retirement in 1990 he owned Unicorn Sportswear in the Empire State Building in New York City. In September 1991 he moved to St. Michaels, MD.

A member of the St. Michaels Catholic Chapel, St. Michaels, MD, he was also an active member of the Miles River Yacht Club, the Miles River Power Squadron, the YMCA of Talbot County and a volunteer at St. Mary's Museum in St. Michaels.

Mr. Carr is survived by his wife, the former Dorothy Lutz, whom he married September 19, 1953; two daughters, Pamela Demaree and her husband, Duane of Galloway, N.J. and Nancy Vanderhoof and her husband, Jerry of Kill

Devil Hills, N.C.; two sons, Kevin Carr of Arizona and Andrew Carr and his wife, Karen of Galloway, N.J.; one sister, Josephine Esch of Whitestone, N.Y.; seven grandchildren and one great grandchild. He was predeceased by a sister, Ann Courtney and a brother, John Carr.
