



## George Godfrey Rebmann

George Godfrey Rebmann of Easton, MD died on Monday, June 17, 2002 at William Hill Health Care, Easton. He was 87.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, December 3, 1914, he was the son of the late George G. and Eleanor Miller Rebmann. After graduating from Olney High School in 1933, he received an Associates Degree in Interior Design from the Philadelphia Museum School of Art in 1935. He was then associated with the Scott Showalter Company in Philadelphia until serving in the U.S. Navy where he was a radar operator on destroyers in both the European and Pacific Theatres of Operation. Following his release from active duty in 1946, he was a partner in Rebmann, Inc. Interior Decorators and Furniture in Newtown Square, PA until 1959. At that time he moved to Easton, MD where he was a partner in George Rebmann, Interiors until the sale of that business in 1983.

A member of Christ Church, St. Michaels, he was also a member of the Talbot County Historical Society, Easton Elks Lodge #1622 and the Easton Rotary Club where he was a Senior Active Member and a Paul Harris Fellow. He was a former member of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary and the Maryland Saltwater Sport Fisherman's Association.

His hobbies included fishing and furniture making at his workshop at home.

Mr. Rebmann is survived by his wife, the former Emmalean L. Coleman whom he married August 5, 1963; a sister-in-law, Laura Rebmann and a nephew, Dallas Rebmann, both of the Philadelphia area.

Memorial graveside services will be held at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton on Thursday, June 20, 2002 at 11:00 AM.
