March 30, 1923 - February 21, 2011

George Harvey Brower died on February 21, 2011. He was 87 years old.

Born on March 30, 1923, he was the son of the late, William Reade and Dorothy C. Miller Brower. Mr. Brower earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Lehigh University on February 20, 1944 in Engineering and Physics. He served in the United States Navy during World War II, and then embarked on a 30-year engineering career with Bendix, becoming a Division Director in Taiwan, China. After residing in Crofton for 20 years and Edgewater for 10 years, Mr. Brower made his home in Easton in 1999.

Mr. Brower enjoyed hunting and fishing. He participated in Marriage Encounter in Crofton, ROMEOS (Retired Old Men Eating Out) in St. Michaels, and Alpha Lambda Omega Fraternity. He was active in his church, serving as the Advent Ministries Chair, an usher, greeter, and on finance, wellness and outreach committees. Mr. Brower volunteered for Relay for Life in Anne Arundel County and was a Relay participant in Talbot County. He volunteered with Pets on Wheels and was a founding member of Prostate Support Group, both in Anne Arundel County.

He is survived by his wife, Jeanne Chaney Brower of Easton; his children, Nancy Brower Hanna (Robert Hanna) of Parkton, David Jeffrey Brower (Susan Jayne Brower) of Reisterstown, Thomas George Brower (Jane Foust

Brower) of Marysville, Ohio, and Joanna Brower Radcliffe (Thomas Radcliffe) of Ridgely; his brother, Richard Brower of Rockland, Maine; eleven grandchildren; and eleven great-grandchildren, with another expected shortly. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Patricia Wyler Brower, who died in 1983; his brother William Brower; and his granddaughter, Jessica Brower McGonigal.

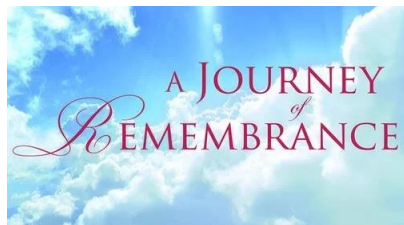
