George H. Roberts died on July 13, 2010 in Easton, MD. He was 67 years old.

Born in Woodbury, NJ on May 29, 1943, he was the son of the late, Richardson Smith and Ruth Mae Hickman Roberts. After living for a time in Lewes, DE, Mr. Roberts' family moved to Haddon Heights, NJ. He graduated from Haddon Heights High School in 1961, and then served in the Air Force from 1967 until 1971. He graduated from the University of Delaware with a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting in 1971, his CPA in 1974, and an MBA in 1981. Mr. Roberts spent his career in utility finance. He worked for American Water Works for 22 years and then served as the Chief Financial Officer for Easton Utilities. Additionally, he had a business management and financial consulting practice in Newark, DE.

Mr. Roberts loved playing golf with his friends and watching the Philadelphia Phillies.

He is survived by his wife, Margaret Hoyle Roberts, whom he married on December 26, 1970; his daughters, Lisa Jane Roberts of Cordova and Ann H. Durandetta and her husband, Bradley, of Wilmington, DE; two brothers, Richardson Smith Roberts, Jr. of Maple Shade, NJ, and Douglas Alan Roberts and his wife, Marnie Patrick Roberts, of Calgary, Alberta; and several nieces.
