George Marion Taylor, of Easton, died at his home on Friday, July 25, 2003. He was 78.

Born in Easton, MD, February 1, 1925, he was the son of the late George S. and Laura Elizabeth Chance Taylor. After graduating from Easton High School in 1942, he attended the University of Delaware for a short time before serving in the United States Marine Corps in the Pacific Theatre of Operation during World War II. Following his release from active duty, he returned to the University of Delaware where, in 1951, he earned both his Bachelors and Masters Degree in Chemistry. He also later studied at Penn State University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. During his business career, he was associated with Hercules, Inc. in Wilmington, DE as an executive for over thirty years until retiring in the early 1980's.

A resident of Easton since 1983, he was an avid sailor and a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club in Oxford, MD.

Mr. Taylor is survived by his wife, the former Jane M. Nevius whom he married August 2, 1947; a daughter, Deborah J. Taylor of Seattle, WA; two sons, Jeffrey N. Taylor and his wife, Jenneane, of Landenberg, PA and G. Scott Taylor of Easton, MD; a sister, Sallie Taylor Barnes of Rhodesdale, MD; two brothers, Norris E. Taylor of Easton, MD and Stanley W. Taylor of Cambridge,

MD and six grandchildren, Damian Taylor, Casey Taylor, Jeremy Taylor, Spencer Taylor-Steik, Nathan Taylor and Matthew Taylor. Another son, Steven B. Taylor, died in 1987 and a sister, Frances T. Tarbutton, died in 1999.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, July 30th, at 2 P.M. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD where friends may call one hour prior to service.

Burial will be at the Oxford Cemetery in Oxford, MD.
