Peter George Valuckas of Chestertown, Maryland died at Heron Point on January 4, 2006. He was 84.

Mr. Valuckas was born in Watertown, Connecticut on April 20, 1921, son of the late John and Petronella Savickas Valuckas. As a young man Mr. Valuckas was involved in scouting as a scout and scout leader in Watertown, Connecticut. He graduated from Watertown High School.

In 1939 he joined the U.S. Navy. Mr. Valuckas served in the Pacific Theater aboard the USS Porter which was sunk during the Battle of the Coral Sea. Mr. Valuckas went to work for Connecticut Light and Power and retired in 1983. He was a Watch Engineer at the Norwalk Generating Plant. In 1995 he moved to Heron Point in Chestertown, Maryland. He was a member of the National Rifle Association and a past member of the V.F.W.

Mr. Valuckas is survived by two sons: George Valuckas of Northeast, Maryland and Charles John Valuckas of Utica, New York; one daughter: Nancy Gilbert of Danbury, Connecticut, five grandchildren and two sisters.
