George Redmond Ingersoll, of Trappe, MD, died on Saturday, August 7, 2004 at the Chesapeake Woods Center, Cambridge where he had resided for the last three years. He was 80.

Born in Salisbury, MD on February 29, 1924, he was the son of the late G. Harold and Margaret A. Ingersoll. After graduating from Wicomico High School, he served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.
