George Robert (Bobby) Cole of Easton, MD died at his home on Friday, March 16, 2007. He was 88.

Born November 4, 1918 in Laurel, MD, he was the son of the late Dr. George W. and Pearle E. Moffat Cole. After graduating in 1936 from Laurel High School, he worked as an electrician. In 1941 he joined the Maryland State Police as a clerk until reaching the age when he could be admitted to the Police Academy. During World War II, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and earned an OCS commission. In 1946 he returned to the Maryland State Police serving in positions of increasing responsibility throughout the state until his retirement in 1969 as Captain and Chief of Training at the State Police Academy at Pikesville Headquarters.

In his early years, Mr. Cole enjoyed climbing high towers, driving fast cars and riding motorcycles. His hobbies included camping, fishing, woodworking, sailing out of Solomon's Island and flying out of Frederick.

On March 21, 1937, George married his high school sweetheart, Carrie Ellen "Dottie" Haslup. "Dottie" passed on March 1, 1993. His second wife, Margaret Salzman Haslup, whom he married July 8, 1995, died December 26, 2000.

Mr. Cole is survived by a son, Robert Haslup Cole and his wife Jean of

Pleasanton, CA; a brother, Albert P. Cole of Luray, VA; two sisters, Ethel M. Huggard of Ft. Lauderdale, FL, and Mary Anne Gooch of Hendersonville, NC; a sister-in-law, Belle Cole of Laurel, MD; two grandsons, Robert and Bradley; and three great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by two brothers, Lycircus and James Moffat Cole.
