Gerald (Jerry) Frost Skipper, 69, died on December 20, 2017, surrounded by family and friends. Born March 4, 1948, in Trappe, MD, he was the son of the late Wilburt Carroll Skipper and Mary Elizabeth Towers Skipper.

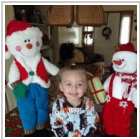
