Gerald "Jerry" W. Hoxter, of Chester, MD., passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday, April 20, 2011.

Born March 28, 1944, Jerry was the son of the late William Leonard and Catherine Esther Skinner-Hoxter. Jerry lived his entire life in Queen Anne's County and was a graduate of Stevensville High School, Class of 1962. He worked as a waterman, repaired boats, built boats and completed many woodworking jobs on yachts. He retired after selling Island Yacht Maintenance at Piney Narrows Marina. Jerry was an avid hunter when he was able and a fisherman who never liked to just take a ride on the boat – if you weren't catching fish, it wasn't worth the trip. He was a member of Bay Country Moose and Sons of the American Legion.

Mr. Hoxter is survived by his wife of 21 years, Trudy (Hansel) Hoxter; a son, Clinton W. Hoxter of Pittsville, MD.; a daughter, Janet L. Rodgers of Winder, GA.; and granddaughter Sara Ann Hoxter, and her mother, Amy Hopkins.

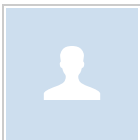
