



Gerald W. Clark

January 11, 1933 - August 17, 2008

Gerald Wilson Clark of St. Michaels, MD, formerly of Oxford, died on Sunday, August 17, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 75.

Born January 11, 1933 in Erie, PA, he was the son of the late Virgil and Kathryn Statham Clark. After graduating from Mill Creek High School, Erie, PA in 1951, he served in the U.S. Army. Following his release from active duty he attended the Oregon College of Education in Eugene, Oregon. After graduation he began a career with Kaiser Aluminum, first in Erie, PA in the sales dept., he was then transferred to Rocky River, Ohio as credit manager and finally to Cold Spring Harbor, Long Island, NY; where he was customer service manager until his retirement, in 1983. After retiring he and his family moved to Oxford, MD; and for the next twenty-one years owned and operated the 1876 House, as well as the 1876 limousine service. While operating the bed and breakfast, and limo service, he also worked for Black & Decker until the closing of the Easton plant and at the time of his death was a delivery driver for Watkins Auto Supply. He had been a resident of St. Michaels since 2004.

He was a member of the Kaiser Retirees Association and B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge 1622.

Mr. Clark is survived by his wife, the former Eleanor Gustafson, whom he

married in 1960; three daughters, Lisa A. Clark of Odenton, MD, Lynne A. Clark and her fiancée James M. Davis, both of Easton, MD; and Robyn M. Kealy and her husband Michael of McDaniel, MD; a sister-in-law, Nancy Clark of Wittman, MD; and two grandchildren, Ryleigh and Brandon Kealy. He was predeceased by his brother, William Clark; and sister, Virginia Forbes.
