



Gerard Xavier Storer

June 28, 1932 - November 11, 2022

Gerard Xavier Storer of Centreville, MD, passed away on November 11, 2022. He was 90 years old.

Born in Washington, DC on June 28, 1932, he was the son of the late John W. and Nellie Mudd Storer.

After graduating from Gonzaga University in 1950, he served in the United States Marine Corps. Upon his honorable discharge, he attended Georgetown University before going to work in traffic management with JB Kendall Co. in 1956. In 1957, he married the former Gretchen Leichtfried, and the couple made their home in New Carrollton, MD. In 1963, Mr. Storer began his career in material management first with the United States Navy and then, beginning in 1975, with the US Coast Guard, from which he retired in 1990. In 2006, the Storer family moved to Centreville, MD.

Mr. Storer enjoyed traveling to all parts of the world. He was very social and enjoyed spending time with his friends in various activities. He was a member of Our Mother of Sorrows Catholic Church and the Jeff Davis American Legion Post 18, both in Centreville, MD.

He is survived by his daughters: Diana Haussmann (Kevin), Suzanne Johnston (Bill), and Jennifer Perlin (Andrew); grandchildren: Matthew, Heidi (Erick), Greta (Victor), Gabrielle, Morgan (Michael), Ryan (Amanda), Nicholas, Julia, Matthew, Zachary and Drew; great grandchildren Jack Finley Armstrong and Audrey Grace Armstrong, Ellie Kate and Addison Grace Weinstein, and Evelyn June Johnston.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased in death by his wife of 52 years, Gretchen Storer; brothers Ernie Storer and John Storer; and sister Mary Frances Englert.
