



Gertrud Ida Hain

June 14, 1924 - January 28, 2018

Gertrud Ida Hain of Stevensville, MD passed away peacefully on January 28, 2018 at her home. She was 93.

Born on June 14, 1924 in Breslau, Germany, she was the daughter of the late Otto and Ida Lieb Hellebrand. She attended a private all girls school in Breslau and would earn her degree in physics from Goettingen University under the well know physicist of the times. After marrying her husband, they moved to Brazil for three years to pursue his career. Once they moved back to Germany Gertrud and her husband began the Plasmaphysik Institut in Munich, Germany. They then moved to the United States in 1964. Gertrud was a scientist and a pioneer woman in the computer programming field and her work included Apollo 5 and work at the Naval Ressearch Laboratory.

Gertrud and her husband loved adventure on both land and sea with many days spent sailing to the north and south. Their love of the Chesapeake Bay led them to purchase land on Kent Island where they built a house designed by their daughter. They enjoyed the beautiful waters of the Chesapeake and the home allowed her husband to continue his research right from the dock, and the grandchildren to enjoy the clear waters of the time.

Gertrud is survived by her children Nicola Hain; Klaus Hain; grandchildren Atalante; Phaedon; Leandros; and five great grandchildren. She was predeceased by her husband Klaus Stephan Heinrich Hain.

A memorial service will be held on March 24th at 10 am at the Christ Church Parish, 830 Romancoke Road, Stevensville, MD 21666.
