



Gertrude E. Cadogan

November 17, 1919 - April 7, 2012

Gertrude Elizabeth “Trudy” Cadogan of Stevensville, MD, died on April 7, 2012, at Genesis Healthcare’s Severna Park Center. She was 92.

Born in Greencastle, PA, on November 17, 1919, she was the daughter of the late John Edward Walck and Elsie Marie Burkett Walck. She grew up in Greencastle and graduated from Waynesboro High School in 1937. On July 24, 1946, she married Paul W. Cadogan.

The Cadogans resided in Baltimore, MD, until 1958, at which time they moved to Severna Park, MD. In 1978, they retired to Englewood, FL. After Mr. Cadogan’s death, Mrs. Cadogan moved to Stevensville in 2000. In 2003, she moved to Terrapin Grove.

Mrs. Cadogan was a very active volunteer both in Florida, where she gave her time at the Englewood Hospital, and in Maryland, where she volunteered at the Percy Senior Center. She also worked as the first receptionist at the Terrapin Grove Apartments. She was the first recipient of the Senior Volunteer of the Year Award for Queen Anne’s County in 2002. Trudy was most recently recognized for 300 volunteer hours at the Kent Island Senior Center at the age of 90.

Mrs. Cadogan was a member of St. Christopher’s Catholic Church and the

American Legion Ladies Auxiliary Post 278. She enjoyed making crafts, volunteering, and walking.

She is survived by her children, Michael P. Cadogan (Chrissy) of Shalimar, FL, David J. Cadogan (Cindi) of Pasadena, MD, and Paula C. Grimes (John) of Stevensville, MD; six grandchildren, Stephanie, John Paul, Colleen, Katie, Mickey, and Andrew; and five great-grandchildren, Wesley, Landon, Cecilia, Mason and Bryce.
