Gertrude Antoinette Cowen Maltby of Centreville, MD died at the Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis, MD on Tuesday, August 7, 2007 surrounded by her loving family. She was 73.

Born in Decatur, Indiana on June 7, 1934, she was the daughter of the late James George and Marian Carey Cowen. She grew up in Wabash, Indiana where she went to high school. Following graduation from high school she received her nursing degree from Holy Cross School of Nursing in South Bend, IN. She was a surgical nurse in the Davis Clinic in Indiana. She moved to Michigan and she worked at Blodgett Hospital as a surgical nurse. On June 1, 1957 she married John Michael Maltby in Wabash, IN. In the early 1960's they moved to Maryland where she raised her family. She helped to establish the Holy Cross Hospital Emergency Room in Silver Spring, MD, she also worked at the Walter Reed Army Medical Hospital. She was the Director of Clinical nursing at Randolph Hills Nursing Home in Wheaton, MD where she retired in 2001. Mr. Maltby died December 24, 2002.

She was an avid reader and loved to sew. Her pride and joy were her grandchildren. She was a season ticket holder for the Washington Redskins and loved spending time at the beach in Ocean City.
