George Kenneth Haddaway, Sr. of Grasonville, MD died suddenly on March 21, 2003 in Grasonville, MD. He was 67.

Born on November 21, 1935 in Grasonville, MD, he was the son of V. Elizabeth Reamy and the late George Cleveland Haddaway. He was a graduate of Stevensville High School class of 1953 and during his high school years Kenny was known as a great athlete. In 1961 he starting working for Trumpy's Yacht Builders in Eastport Annapolis, MD and when Trumpy's Yacht Builders closed, he was working as a foreman.
