



## Gladstone E. Parker

Gladstone E. "G.E." Parker of Easton, MD died on Saturday, February 16, 2008, at Genesis Health Care the Pines. He was 93.

Born May 7, 1914 in Orr's Mountain, West Virginia, he was the son of the late Arthur and Janie Kimble Parker. After attending public school in West Virginia, he worked as a carpenter. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II. In 1952 he moved to Easton, MD, with a position with Hollock Construction Company and later worked as Assistant Town Engineer for the Town of Easton, where he remained until his retirement.

On April 8, 1939 he married the former Audrey Louise Hall. Mrs. Parker died March 23, 1994.

He was a member of the St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Cordova, a member of the VFW Post #5118 where he served as a past commander, and was well known throughout the area for his picture framing.

Mr. Parker is survived by two daughters, Jane P. Greenhalgh of Royal Oak, MD and Fay P. Sauca and her husband Carl of Cordova, MD; three sisters, Alda Brannon of Clearbrook, VA, Eva Snyder Widmyer of Lahmansville, West Virginia, and Ruth Barley of Winchester, VA; one brother, Arthur E. Parker of Winchester, VA; three grandchildren, Stephanie Licata, Sam Sauca and his

wife Wendy and Stacie Rice and her husband Chris; and four great-grandchildren, Madalyn Sauca, Carlie Licata, Addison Rice ,and Morgan Sauca. He was predeceased by a sister, Esther P. Seabright.
