



## Gladys Kincaid

August 11, 1934 - July 10, 2011

Gladys Marie Glanding Kincaid of Sudlersville, MD died Sunday, July 10, 2011 at her home in Sudlersville. She was 76.

Mrs. Kincaid was born August 11, 1934 in Barclay, MD the daughter of the late, Thomas Glanding and Hattie "Glanden" Glanding.
