



Gladys Reba Whitby

January 13, 1924 - November 25, 2014

Gladys Reba Whitby of Centreville, MD, left peacefully to be with the Lord on November 25, 2014. She was 90.

Born on January 13, 1924, in Centreville, she was the daughter of the late Robert Lee Dill and Estella Russum, and grew up on Tilghman Neck Road. She attended school in Centreville, and on April 8, 1941, she married Winnie Perry Whitby. The couple made their home in the Town of Centreville. Gladys was a homemaker until 1962, when she and her husband purchased The Flying A in Centreville. They owned and operated Whitby's Service Station until their retirement in 1983.

She loved playing bingo and sewing, making all of her own clothing, and providing alterations for those she knew. She also enjoyed craft projects. She was a member of the Gloryland Tabernacle in Centreville.

She is survived by her four children, Winnie P. "Casey" Whitby, Jr. (JoAnn) of Ruthsburg, MD, Darleen Whitby, Dale Whitby, and Mark Whitby (Geri), all of Centreville, MD; nine grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren; and one great-great-grandchild. She was predeceased by all of her siblings, Madeline Stafford, Myrtle Schwitzer, Pearl Stanley; Robert Dill, Jimmy Dill, and William "Bill" Dill. She was preceded in death by her husband, Winnie Perry Whitby, who died in 1986; and a grandson, Christopher Coursey, who died in 2006.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, December 2 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, MD, where family and friends may visit on Monday from 6-8 p.m. Burial will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton, MD.
