Gladys Browning Glenn of Chestertown, Maryland died on November 15, 2006 at Chester River Manor in Chestertown. She was 89.

Born in West Virginia on April 10, 1917, she was the daughter of the late Edward P. and Josephine Hudnall Lee.

Mrs. Glenn graduated from Logan High School in West Virginia and Charleston University, she then earned a Masters Degree from Marshall University. She began teaching English in 1960 with the Logan County School System. She married Cap A. Glenn in 1964, they resided in West Logan. Mrs. Glenn also taught English with Marshall University and Southern West Virginia Community College (a branch of Marshall). She taught English for over 30 years. In 2002 her husband predeceased her and later that year she moved to Chestertown, Maryland.

She was a member of The Order of the Eastern Star #60 in Logan where she served on the state level. She was also a member of Beta Sigma Phi Sorority, a past president of the Women's Club of Logan, and a past president of the Logan Garden Club. Mrs. Glenn was honored for volunteering over 3,000 hours of service to Logan General Hospital.

She is survived by two sons: Gordon Browning and his wife Eva of Chestertown, MD, and Charles E. Browning, PhD. and his wife Sandra of Dayton, Ohio, two grandchildren: Melissa Browning of Dayton, Ohio and Byron Browning and his wife Kathleen of Annandale, Virginia, along with three great grandchildren: Olivia, Madison, and Hunter Browning. Two siblings

predeceased her Earl Preston "Bob" Lee and Mary Sampson.
