



## Gladys S. Quidas

Gladys S. Quidas of Trappe, MD died on Sunday, November 13, 2005 at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines. She was 87.

Born May 25, 1918 in Easton, she was the daughter of the late Curtis C. and Elizabeth Miller Satchell. After attending public school, she worked in home care until her marriage to John Harvey Quidas in March of 1941. During World War II, they lived in Baltimore until May of 1945 when they moved to Trappe where she assisted her husband in the operation of their business, Quidas' Garage. From 1964 until 1981 they had the franchise for the delivery of the Baltimore Sun and Washington Post newspapers from Easton to Oxford and to the Choptank River. She was also well known for her home canning business that she operated for a number of years. Following the death of her husband in July 2000, she remained active in the family business until retiring in 2001.

A life member and Past President of the Trappe Vol. Fire Company Ladies Auxiliary, she was also a former member of the Easton Soroptomist Club and a former Cub Scout Leader of Pack 189.

Mrs. Quidas is survived by two sons, Robert F. Quidas and his wife Shirley, and John H. Quidas, Jr. and his wife Doris all of Trappe; a sister, Elizabeth Mitchell of Jamesburg, NJ; two brothers, Lester Satchell of Federalsburg, and

William Satchell of Savannah, GA; four grandchildren, Tammy Quidas, Lisa Bryan, Tracey Dickerson, and Kimberly Williams; and two great-grandchildren, Grayson Bryan and Morgan Dickerson. She was predeceased by a son, Jackie Quidas; a sister, Doris Lomax; and three brothers, Curtis Satchell, Lawrence Satchell and Francis "Sally" Satchell.

Funeral services will be held on Friday November 18, 2005 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton, MD. Friends may call on Thursday evening from 6 to 8 PM and one hour prior to the service on Friday.
