



Glenn Hewitt Clevenger

August 17, 1937 - December 29, 2024

Glenn H. Clevenger from Centreville, MD passed away on December 29, 2024 at Arcadia Living in Denton, MD. He was born on August 17, 1937, in Crystal City, Missouri, and has lived on the Eastern Shore for 22 years.

He and his wife, Sandra, have been married for 65 years and have a son , Glenn Jr., and a daughter, Cheryl Matsumura. He has six grandchildren, four great grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.

He is survived by a brother, Ronald and a sister, Sue Raymer who both reside in Missouri, and a sister-in-law and husband, Martha and Roy James, who reside in Pelion, SC.

Glenn graduated from Crystal City High School in June 1955 and joined the U.S. Airforce shortly after. He qualified and wanted to be a pilot, but because of his age, 17, he was not allowed. In later years, he earned his private pilot's license.

While in the U.S. Airforce , he was stationed at San Antonio, Texas, and Crete, Greece. He ended his tour of duty in Fort Meade where he was in the service of the National Security Agency. He met Sandra while located in Fort Meade.

Glenn wore many hats! After retiring from the Airforce he became a Laurel,

MD , policeman for five years. He then changed careers, becoming a State Farm Agent for 35 years. During this time he was with the Laurel Rescue Squad for five years, obtained his pilot's license, and entertained many as a square dance caller for twelve years.

When he and Sandra both retired, they moved from their home in Scaggsville, Howard County, to the Eastern Shore. Glenn joined the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary (Flotilla 19-03 Kent Island) for five years and served as Flotilla Leader for one term. Glenn started to develop some memory problems and decided to retire from the flotilla.

At this time, no service is planned. Later in the Spring the family will host a celebration of his life for his family and friends.
