



## Glenn A. Smith

April 8, 1928 - April 27, 2016

Glenn Alonza Smith died peacefully on April 27, 2016, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was 88.

Mr. Smith was born April 8, 1928 in Easton, MD. He was the son of the late Alonza Smith and Mary Johannah Thom Smith.
