Gloria Jean "Jeanne" Johnson of Marydel, MD, died Wednesday, October 7, 2015, at her home in Marydel, MD. She was 67.

Jeanne was born September 23, 1948, in Chestertown, MD, the daughter of the late Nelson Grier Emory and Marjorie "Hignutt" Emory. Mrs. Johnson was a 1966 graduate of Queen Anne's County High. She continued her education and earned her Child Development credentials and opened a private daycare. Jeanne loved children and soon started teaching at the Eastern Shore Junior Academy and then at the Chester River Adventist School. Jeanne also taught kindergarten in Grasonville. She also drove a school bus, and worked as a courier.

Mrs. Johnson was very active in the Seventh Day Adventist church where she played a major role in conducting the food pantry, active in Women's Ministry, and sat on both the church and the school board. Throughout her life she had a passion for animals and nature, she enjoyed singing, running, helping with Vacation Bible School and spending time with children. Jeannie had a heart of gold and spread her love to everyone she came in contact with.

She is survived by her husband, Joseph Johnson, Sr., of Marydel, MD; one daughter, Denver Radcliffe and husband Timothy of Millington, MD; two grandchildren, Savannah Jones and Austin Squire, both of Millington, MD;

three sisters-in-law and one brother-in-law and their spouses; three stepdaughters; six stepsons and their spouses; twenty step-grandchildren; one step-great-grandchild; and a few very close spiritual sisters and brothers that she loved very deeply, as well as a host of other family and friends.

Services will be held Sunday, October 18, 2015, at 12 p.m. at the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Chestertown. A visitation will be held one hour prior to the service.

Interment will be held on Monday, October 19, 2015, privately for family and friends at the Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock, MD.
