Gloria was very competitive with sports and loved softball, bowling, and golf. In her younger years, she played softball for a local Kent Island team called the Bay Siders. She then found herself bowling and playing golf with her girlfriends all over the country. She spent her final years with her husband and son in Wilmington, NC, watching her grandchildren excel at softball, baseball, and multiple other sports.

Gloria was adopted as a young child and never knew her birth family. Five years before she passed, her siblings tracked her down to make contact. Meeting her birth family was a very special point in her life that allowed her to rest easy in her final days.

Gloria was preceded in death by her husband of 60 years Reginald “Reggie” Jones. She is survived by her son, Willard and his wife Ashley; two grandchildren, Morgan and Dylan; and sisters, Thelma Kohnen and Georgetta

Ridenour.
