Goldwin Dyke of Chestertown, Maryland died on January 19, 2007 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown, Maryland. He was 95.

Born in Sidney, Nebraska on February 1, 1911 he was the son of the late Robert Edward and Amelia Johnson Dyke. He graduated Sydney High School and attended Culver Stockten College. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1932 until 1936 when he was honorably discharged. Mr. Dyke had a 40 year career with the Federal Aviation Administration. He moved to Chestertown, Maryland in 1996. An accomplished artist, Mr. Dyke enjoyed painting on canvas, gardening, and raising goldfish.

He was predeceased by his wife the late Evelyn Waureeta Lanterman Dyke on January 27, 2000.

He is survived by a son: Robert Dyke of Vera Beach, Florida, a sister: Genevieve Bauer of Sidney, Nebraska, a granddaughter: Tracy Dyke-Redmond and a great granddaughter: Cora Redmond. One son the late James Dyke along with a brother the late Robert Dyke predeceased him.
