



Gordon Fraser Lee Jr.

May 9, 1978 - August 19, 2024

Gordon F. Lee Jr., 46, of Easton, Maryland passed away on August 19th, 2024 due to natural causes. Gordon was born on May 9th, 1978 in Plainfield, New Jersey. He grew up with three sisters in Flemington, New Jersey while attending Hunterdon Central High School.

During his years of high school, Gordon met his future wife, Courtnee Shinn Lee. He graduated from Hunterdon Central High School in 1996 and promptly joined the Marine Corps on January 14th, 1997. While in the Marine Corps, Gordon served with 2/8 Weapons Co. and was deployed to Greece, Ireland, Japan and Korea. On March 8th, 1999, Gordon and Courtnee wed in Flemington, New Jersey. On November 1st, 2000 Gordon F. Lee Jr. was promoted to Sergeant with the Marine Corps. During his time in the military, Gordon was awarded various awards and/or accomplishments from 1997 to 2001.

Following his honorable discharge from the Marine Corps, Gordon joined the Easton Police Department on January 03, 2001. Throughout his extensive career spanning over 23 years, Gordon spent time with both the SWAT and K9 Division of the Easton PD with his beloved K9, Flex. During his career, First Sergeant Lee diligently served his community earning him over 20 various awards to include a Bronze Star. While off duty, Gordon enjoyed spending time with his family and friends, his dogs, his Jeep, his whiskey and

his guns. He took pleasure in being a mentor to the community through his business, Boston Cliff Training, that he established in 2021. He was a respected member of the Fraternal Order of Police and The Emerald Society, the former of which he served as President.

Gordon is survived by his loving wife of 25 years, Courtnee, his son Ryan and daughter Karissa. He will be terribly missed by his dogs Buford, Sox and Gus.
