



Gorman Cummings Jr.

March 13, 1920 - January 31, 2015

Gorman “Sam” Cummings, Jr., of Easton, MD, died on January 31, 2015, at William Hill Manor. He was 94.

Born in Fairbanks, Tilghman, MD, on March 13, 1920, he was the son of the late Gorman Sr. and Addie Bradshaw Cummings. After graduating from Tilghman High School, he enlisted in the United States Navy. He returned home as a decorated World War II veteran. On May 20, 1946, Sam married Dorothy Howeth, and they made their home in Fairbank, Tilghman until moving to Easton, MD, in 1957. He worked at Noble Rebuilders and then Waverly Press until retirement.

A lifelong resident of Talbot County, he was a lifetime member of VFW Post # 5118 in Easton and DAV (Disabled American Veterans).

Sam is survived by two grandchildren, Shelly Cummings and Craig Cummings (Sara); and three great-grandchildren, Molly, Mark, and Madelyn Cummings of NC; and a son-in-law, Robert Hogan of FL.

He is preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy, who passed away eleven days prior on January 20, 2015. A daughter, Joyce Cummings Hogan; a son James Howeth Cummings; and sisters; Ruth Ellen Young and Florence M. Gisriel.

A memorial service will be held for both on Saturday, March 14, 2015, at 2 p.m., at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St. in Easton.
