On Monday morning, July 2, 2018, Grace Louise Covington left this life for her last adventure. She was 98.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on September 19, 1919, she grew up in the city, first on Laretta Avenue in a rowhouse and then on to Westgate Rd. Here at age 10, she began her lifelong love of Coca-Cola. She attended P.S. 86 elementary and then Western High School. She and her parents moved to Linthicum in the 1950's.

Grace went on to work for the Barton Gillett Paper Company beginning on the bottom rung of the ladder. Over the next 30 plus years, she worked her way up, retiring as Vice-President.
