



## Grace Mastandrea

October 17, 1926 - February 2, 2023

Grace Mastandrea went home to be with the Lord on February 2, 2023. She was 96.

Born on October 17, 1926 in Astoria, New York, Grace was the daughter of the late Rocco and Margaret Colucci. After graduating from high school, she went to work at the New York Telephone Company.

Grace met the love of her life, Philip Mastandrea, and the two were married on February 6, 1949. After spending their early years in New York, they built a home on Long Island, where they raised their four children and lived for more than thirty years before moving to the Eastern Shore of Maryland in 1992.

Grace's interests throughout her life included cooking (she was a world class chef), sewing, embroidery, knitting, and gardening. Her gardens were spectacular, overflowing with roses, lilacs, and azaleas (and tomatoes). She was a voracious reader as well as a devoted student of the Bible and was always remarkably well-informed about world events.

Grace was a devout Christian who loved and was adored by her children, her grandchildren, and her great grandchildren. Her life was devoted to her faith and to her family. Grace had a larger-than-life personality and a vivacious presence. She was in high heels every day, ready to take on the next adventure. It was a joy to be in her company. Her sense of humor and sharp wit were second to none.

In addition to her parents, Grace was preceded in death by her husband Philip Mastandrea, her son Philip Mastandrea, Jr., and her brother Dominick.

Grace is survived by her daughter Maryann Judy (Gary); son Dr. John Mastandrea (Denise), and daughter Angela Mastandrea Miller (Jeff). In addition, Grace is survived by her nine loving grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
