Granville Adrian Thompson, Jr. of Kent Island, MD, died suddenly on Thursday, December 27, 2018, at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 60.

Born on July 14, 1958, in Easton, MD, he was the son of Granville A. “Lummy” Thompson, Sr. of Chester, MD, and the late Cora “Betty” Collier. He grew up on Kent Island, and as a teenager began working as a waterman for about 18 years until moving into heavy equipment as an operator for the past 30 years. 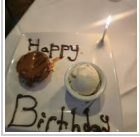
