



## Gregory Parks Barton

March 11, 1951 - June 14, 2013

Gregory Parks Barton from Chester, MD, died Friday, June 14, 2013, at Anne Arundel Medical Center surrounded by his loving family. He was 62.

Born March 11, 1951, in Riverdale, MD, he was the son of Robert Keith Barton and the late Mildred Parks Barton. He attended Prince George's Community College for two years after graduating from Laurel High School.
